- b) SPER Fees
- c) Court Costs

(Note: Any restitution, compensation, witness expenses, fees or other sum of money ordered by the Court must still be paid.)

You cannot apply for a Fine Option Order if:

- a) You have breached a previous Fine Option Order for the same offence; or
- b) An Arrest and Imprisonment Warrant has been issued and executed against you.

Your Fine Option Order application may be declined if:

- a) Your financial assessment indicates you have the capacity to pay; or
- b) You fail to complete this application in full – **all questions must be answered.**

- An Enforcement Warrant authorising an Enforcement Officer to seize and sell real and personal property;
- A Fine Collection Notice to a financial institution for the redirection of all or part of a debt owed, or for the regular redirection from a financial account;
- A Fine Collection Notice to an employer for the redirection of your earnings;
- An Enforcement Warrant imposing a charge on property, (annuities, debentures, stocks and other property);
- Suspension of your driver licence. If you do not hold a driver licence, you will be prevented from applying for or obtaining one until the debt is paid or otherwise discharged under this Act;
- If the total amount owing on this order is more than \$1000 the Registrar may register an interest in land or any other property (eg Motor Vehicle);
- The Registrar may issue an Arrest and Imprisonment Warrant.
